KD TURKEY FUND



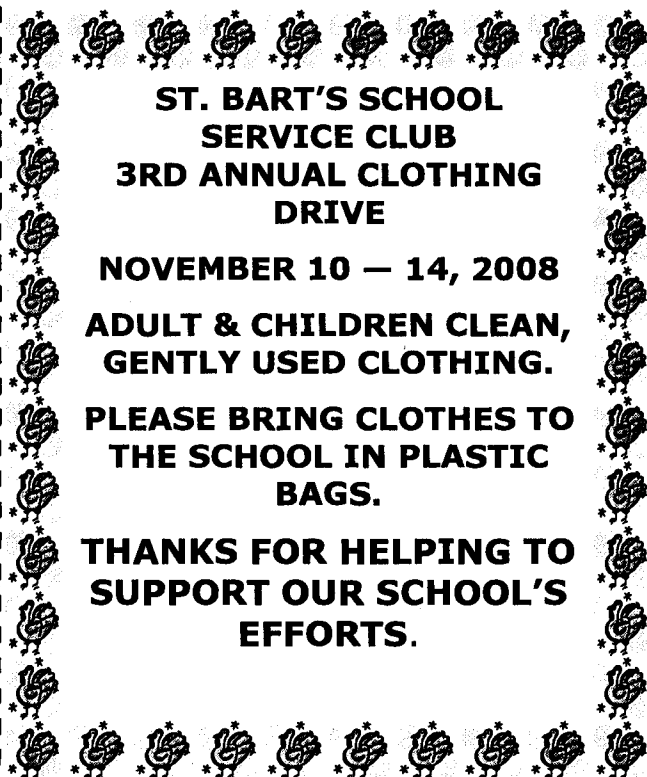
