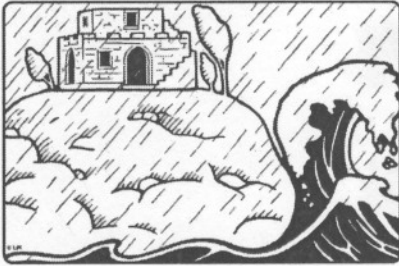


*NINTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY

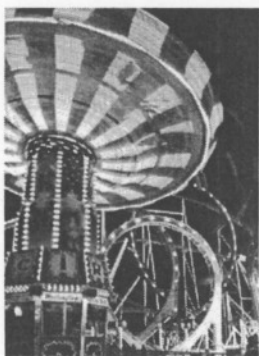

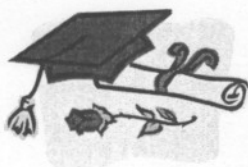
Monday June 2nd,
